



## Important Information Receiving secure e-mail from DHS

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Effective December 20, 2005, the Department of Human Services (DHS) will implement a new system for sending e-mail containing confidential data and protected health information (PHI).

### What this means to you

If DHS sends you, or responds to, e-mail containing specific information about your health, health care claims, eligibility, or other sensitive information, you will receive it through a new secure e-mail system.
