I met with General Rees last Thursday. He expressed that siting a new armory on the DSL property along 19th Street is preferred to all other options that have been made available. Instead of planning for a site large enough to accommodate future construction of a barracks building and a replacement facility for the maintenance activity currently located adjacent to the airport, he prefers a site for a stand alone armory. So, instead of delineating a 20-acre parcel, we can get by with something in the neighborhood of 10-acres. Hopefully, the members of the South Redmond Collaborative Planning Group will find this alternative more palatable.
