* UNTIL 600 PM EDT...

* AT 800 AM EDT...WEATHER SERVICE DOPPLER RADAR INDICATED THAT
OVER 3 INCHES OF RAIN HAD FALLEN OVER PARTS OF THE COUNTY. AN
ADDITIONAL ONE OR TWO INCHES ARE POSSIBLE OVER THE FEW HOURS.

* SOME LOCATIONS IN THE WARNING AREA INCLUDE...
WEST UNION...
BLUE CREEK...

IF FLOODING IS OBSERVED...ACT QUICKLY. MOVE TO HIGHER GROUND TO
ESCAPE FLOOD WATERS. DO NOT STAY IN AREAS SUBJECT TO FLOODING
WHEN WATER BEGINS RISING.

DO NOT DRIVE YOUR VEHICLE INTO AREAS WHERE WATER COVERS THE
ROADWAY. THE WATER DEPTH MAY BE TOO GREAT TO ALLOW YOUR CAR TO
CROSS SAFELY AND THE ROAD BENEATH MAY NOT BE INTACT.

BARRICADES. BE ESPECIALLY CAREFUL AT NIGHT WHEN IT IS NEARLY
IMPOSSIBLE TO TELL THE DEPTH OF FLOODWATERS. TUNE TO NOAA
WEATHER RADIO OR YOUR LOCAL MEDIA OUTLET FOR THE LATEST UPDATES.
