Objectives:

DHS adopted a goal to: *Improve health and reduce morbidity, mortality, and cost through greater coordination and integration of care provided by public and private behavioral health and physical health providers and community-based organizations.*

- Explore state or federal resources available to assist with integration efforts, and
- Facilitate a learning collaborative of public and private partners to promote increased integration and coordination.
