SUBJ: ELIMINATION OF VA DEBT LETTERS

1. <u>EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY</u>, VA Form 26-8937, Verification of VA Benefit-Related Indebtedness (DEBT Letters), will <u>NO</u> <u>LONGER BE REQUIRED</u> unless the following conditions apply:

- The veteran is receiving VA disability benefits;
- The veteran indicates that he/she would be entitled to receive VA disability benefits but for the receipt of retired pay;
- The veteran indicates that he/she has received VA disability benefits in the past; **OR**
- The applicant is a surviving spouse of a veteran who died on active duty or as a result of a service-connected disability.

If your company has submitted a VA Form 26-8937 to our office and it has not been returned as of the scheduled closing date, you may close the loan <u>without</u> the completed form unless the conditions listed above are applicable.
