Texaco Exploration and Production Inc. ("Texaco") appreciates the opportunity to provide comments on the above referenced Minerals Management Service's ("MMS") proposed rule.

Since passage of the Deep Water Royalty Act in 1995, Texaco has participated in a cooperative effort with MMS focused on future royalty relief policies resulting from Deepwater Royalty Relief Act. This effort has been productive and we anticipate continuation of this dialog will be necessary and mutually beneficial as MMS develops and implements royalty relief policies.

This latest rulemaking addressing the discretionary royalty relief program is especially of interest to Texaco because it provides lessees an additional option when evaluating the feasibility of developing a marginal discovery in deepwater. By providing comments to MMS on proposed rulemakings similar to this one, your agency will be in a better position to implement a comprehensive royalty relief program that accomplishes its objectives and provides industry with a more efficient and effective program.
