

Oregon Parks and Recreation Department **Veterans with a service-connected disability** State park special access pass application

Veterans with any level of service-connected disability qualify for a free state park dayuse pass and free state park tent and RV camping in Oregon State Parks. Camping is limited to 5 free days per stay at a single park, and a maximum of 10 days per month in the state park system.

To receive the pass, you need to do the following:

- 1. Obtain a letter from the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (1220 SW 3rd, Portland OR 97204) stating you have a service-connected disability.
- 2. After you receive the letter, complete and sign this application.
- 3. Mail **both** this application **and** your letter from Veteran's Affairs (a copy is fine) to:

You should receive your pass within three weeks.
