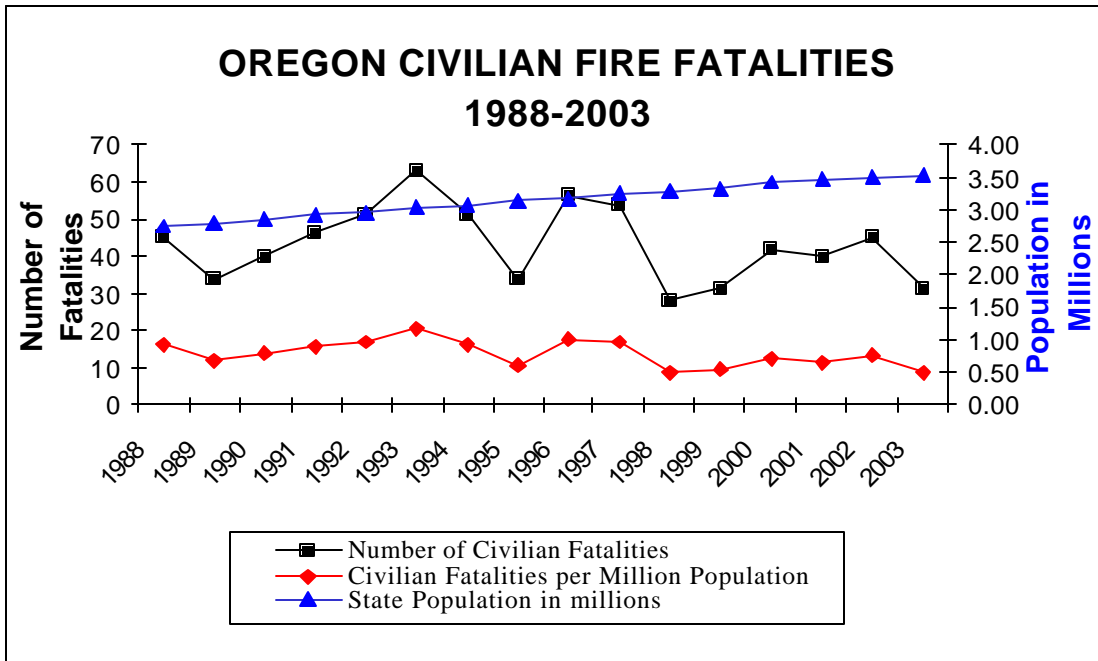
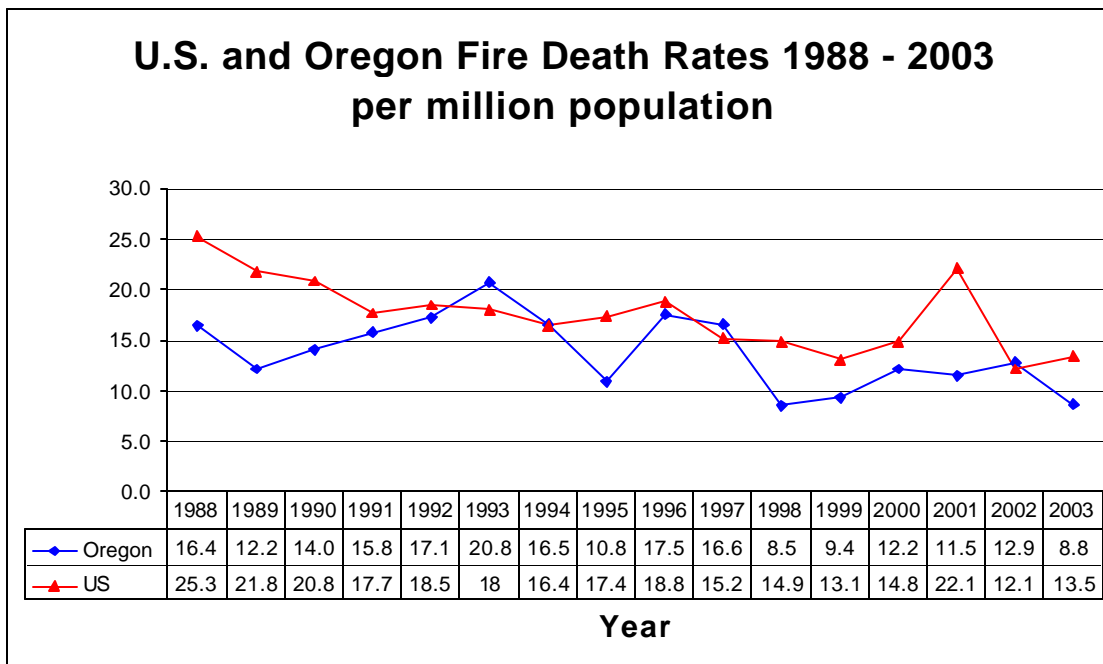


2003 OREGON CIVILIAN FIRE FATALITIES

In 2003, the Oregon fire death rate was 8.8 per million population.



The long-term trend in fire fatalities continues downward, as shown below:



Notes:

U.S. rates are based on estimates from the National Fire Protection Association’s (NFPA) annual fire department survey. The estimates fall within 95% confidence intervals and are statistically significant at the .05 level. NFPA does not follow up on vehicle fire deaths with smaller fire departments to ensure that the deaths were really from the fire, not trauma. The 2001 rate, 22.1, includes the 9-11 incident, without it the rate is 13.4.

Oregon rates are based upon fire department reports in the Oregon All Incident Reporting System.
