Format of Code Change Submittals

Proposed changes shall:

- 1) Meet one of the following criteria:
 - a) Have a benefit to health and safety of the occupants or public;
 - b) Is necessary to conserve scarce resources;
 - c) The issue is unique to Oregon because of geographic or climatic conditions;
 - d) Is necessary because of conflicts with other laws or regulations; or
 - e) Is necessary to correct inadequate code coverage.
- 2) Explain the cost and economic impact of the proposal to the general public, construction industry, local and state government and small business.
- 3) Be formatted as follows:
 - a) Be submitted on forms available from the agency or on reasonable facsimiles and typewritten.
 - b) Text to be deleted shall be shown with a line through the text.
 - c) Text to be added shall be **bolded &** <u>underlined</u>.
 - d) Drawings, photographs, charts or other figures shall be submitted in a form suitable for reproduction.
 - e) Each proposed change shall include a reason along with how the proposal meets one of the criteria described in Section 1.
 - f) Each proposed change must indicate what **Stakeholders** may be affected by the change and if they were contacted.
