

Minimizing Disruptions

- All work producing excessive noise will be done after hours, weekends and holidays.
- Work on the Whitten Building's east & west moat roofs, the contractor will access the roofs through the 4th floor restrooms and/or office space. Restrooms will be closed.
- During construction, windows, AC units, and air intake vents will be covered to minimize odor.
