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Happy holidays, everyone!

This issue of Cardlock News focuses on results of records and facility inspections for 2007. We hope you will take a few minutes to reflect on the statistics provided below. Only 21% of companies inspected were 100% in compliance, which is significantly lower than the established baseline of 70%. The good news is that almost 77% of companies had two or fewer deficiencies. Although this is an improvement, state statutes require all customers to be in compliance at all times; so there is still work to be done.

Results of Records and Facility Inspections for 2007

11,117 Records Inspected

During records inspections conducted this last year, we inspected 11,117 customer records. The most common deficiency is missing proof of business.



Please ensure your maintenance personnel are inspecting your facilities each week. Civil penalties may be imposed for failure to inspect.
