

This section of Arizona's Green Industry grew at a faster pace than any other sector. Between 1998 and 2002, sales grew by 38%.


Landscape Sales by Customer




Sales continue to rise at an astounding pace. Between 1998 and 2002, Arizona's Green Industry grew 31%.

#### Total Nursery Sales: \$501 million Low Water Use Plant Sales: \$235 million





Between 1998 and 2002 Green Industry Employment grew by 24%. The largest increase was in the landscape services sector.




#### Consider Wages and Benefits ...

Wages and benefits paid by the Arizona Green Industry made a huge contribution to Arizona's economy. Between 1998 and 2002, paid wages grew by 59%. The average salary received by Green Industry workers rose by 28% over that same time period.

The Arizona Green Industry spent more than \$1 billion on wages, supplies, vehicles and equipment and other business expenses. Nursery producers and landscape service firms make a huge contribution to Arizona's economy.


