**RESPONDENT’S MOTION FOR EXTENSION  
OF TIME TO FILE ANSWER TO COMPLAINT**

Pursuant to Section 3.12(a) of the Commission’s Rules of Practice, Respondent Kentucky Household Goods Carriers Association, Inc. (“Association”) moves to extend the time for filing its Answer to the Complaint herein to and including August 20, 2003 based on the following circumstances:

Upon information and belief, the Association’s Answer is currently due on August 4, 2003.

The Association’s first opportunity to consider an appropriate course of action to be taken with respect to the within proceeding was at a Special Meeting of the Association’s Board of Directors which was held in Louisville, Kentucky on Wednesday, July 30<sup>th</sup>. It was not until that time that the Association was fully aware of the nature and extent of (a) this proceeding; and (b) the significance of the pleading requirements of the Commission’s Rules of Practice.




