Increase the timeliness rate of submission by 5% in 2004, 2005 and 2006. The timeliness rate is the percentage of claims received by OWCP within 14 calendar days (10 work days). Time begins when the supervisor receives notice based on block 23 on CA-1 and Block 26 on CA-2. Time stops when OWCP District Office receives notice. Claims forms include: CA-1, Federal Notice of Traumatic Injury and Claim for Continuation of Pay and Compensation and CA-2, Notice of Occupational Disease and Claim for Compensation.
