Please consider the following comments during your review of ConocoPhillips proposed divestiture of Colorado assets to Suncor Energy.

In general, I support the sale of these assets to Suncor Energy. I believe Suncor Energy has the resources to make a financial commitment for Clean Fuels investment at the Denver Refinery. This should benefit both the consumer and local economy in general.

However, I am concerned that ConocoPhillips has put Suncor Energy at a competitive disadvantage with respect to the number of Phillips gas stations versus refinery capacity. I am concerned that the supply agreement may not allow the refinery to operate at full capacity. This could be corrected by including additional Conoco gas stations in the divestiture of assets.

With respect to employee benefits and years of service, I wish there was more information in the petition to make an intelligent comment. Many of the employees have spent their entire careers with Conoco. Please ensure that the employees do not become victims of a Federal Trade Commission mandated sale of assets.
