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## North Dakota Agricultural Prices

The Index of Prices Received for All Farm Products in September is 229 percent of the 19901992 base, according to the USDA, National Agricultural Statistics Service, North Dakota Field Office. This is up 24 percent from last year and 78 percent above two years ago. The All Crops Index, at 251 percent of the base, is up 27 percent from September 2007 while the All Livestock and Products Index, at 126 percent, is down 2 percent from last year. September indexes are calculated using preliminary mid-month prices.

The August Index of Prices Received for All Farm Products, recalculated with full month prices, was 235 percent of the base, up 42 percent from August 2007. The All Crops Index, at 272 percent, was up 50 percent from the previous year while the All Livestock and Products Index, at 118 percent, was down 2 percent from August 2007.
