Three Step Process discussed at AHIC:

- Collect information in order to **identify the critical components comprising the broad charge**. (*Identify additional breakthrough focus areas or Use Cases necessary to make this movement*)
- Prioritize the critical components of the broad charge to create a roadmap and a work plan to drive specific recommendations.
- Identify specific recommendations flowing from each critical component.
- 5. Discussion/Drafting of work plan that lays out the <u>critical components</u> of the **broad charge and a process to address them**. (* Primary meeting objective)
- 6. Discussion/ Decision on recommendations surrounding the First Responder EHR
 - Recent release of emergency response focused RFI's
