Recognizing that the purpose of Energy Star is to help consumers identify the most efficient products available, we believe that an additional meeting with manufacturers and other industry leaders is necessary in order to adequately evaluate the comments and concerns that have been expressed for this program. Those concerns include: specific warranty criteria; the lack of a requirement for the water heater be listed as complying with the nationally recognized safety standard; and the exclusion of electric resistance storage, electric resistance tankless, and oil-fired storage water heaters from an ENERGY STAR program.

We request that DOE schedule an additional public workshop prior to the scheduled release of the final ENERGY STAR criteria for the residential water heater program.
