DISMISSAL ORDER

This matter having been duly noticed for hearing in Honolulu, Hawaii, pursuant to 20 C.F.R. Parts 626 *et seq.* and 29 C.F.R. Part 18, and the Respondent having thereafter filed a "Motion to Dismiss" on February 11, 1998, on the ground, *inter alia*, that the Federated States of Micronesia (FSM) had supplied documentation to the Grant Officer "which has enabled DOL to allow all of the costs, \$165,751.00, that had been disallowed pursuant to the audit of the FSM's expenditures under the Job Training Partnership Act that had given rise to Case No. 97-JTP-4," and that "all issues raised by this case have been resolved," I find there are no further issues for adjudication. The Motion is therefore GRANTED and the matter referred for hearing is DISMISSED.
