**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO WITHDRAW**

This case arises under the Job Training Partnership Act (JTPA), 29 U.S.C. § 1579(a); and the applicable regulations at 20 C.F.R. Part 636.

After audit of Grant Number AC-10715-00-55, on September 24, 2004, the Employment and Training Administration of the United States Department of Labor informed Arkansas Human Development Corporation (Complainant) that the aforementioned grant contained questioned costs and administrative deficiencies in a Final Determination. On October 13, 2004, Complainant requested a hearing before the Office of Administrative Law Judges (Office) in this matter. This Office issued a Notice of Docketing on October 27, 2004, instructing the parties to file and submit certain information to this Office.

By letter dated November 30, 2004, Complainant stated that the issues have been resolved. Accordingly, Complainant seeks to withdraw the complaint and the request for hearing. No objection has been received.

In light of the foregoing, Motion to Withdraw is hereby GRANTED.
