ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO WITHDRAW

This case arises under the Job Training Partnership Act (JTPA), 29 U.S.C. § 1579(a); and the applicable regulations at 20 C.F.R. Part 636.

After audit of Grant Number AF-10995-01-60, in a Final Determination dated March 8, 2005, the Employment and Training Administration of the United States Department of Labor (Respondent) informed the State of California Department of Industrial Services (Complainant) that the aforementioned Grant contained questioned costs. On March 25, 2005, Complainant requested an administrative hearing before the Office of Administrative Law Judges (Office) in this matter. This Office issued a Notice of Docketing on April 8, 2005, instructing the parties to file and submit certain information to this Office.

By letter dated April 14, 2005, Complainant informed this Office that the disallowed amount was reduced to zero balance by Respondent. This action obviates the need to proceed further in this matter. In light of the foregoing, Complainant seeks to withdraw the request for hearing. No objection has been received.

Accordingly, the Motion to Withdraw is hereby GRANTED.
