

ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On April 16, 1990, Complainant, the Shoshone and Arapaho Tribes Employment and Training (hereinafter SATET) notified this office of its intent to appeal Final Determinations, dated March 21, 1990, which alleged disallowed costs totaling \$28,433.00 in Audit No. 06-89-306-03-355.

On January 16, 1991, Respondent, the U.S. Department of Labor (hereinafter DOL) filed a letter stating that the Grant Officer informed SATET that all costs in the above-referenced case have been allowed and that no further costs in this matter remain disallowed. Therefore, DOL requests dismissal of the appeal and states that SATET has no objection to this request.

Accordingly, I hereby ORDER the above-captioned case DISMISSED.
