

ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter arises under the Job Training Partnership Act, 29 U.S.C. § 1501 et seq., and the regulations issued thereunder at 20 C.F.R. Part 629.

On June 27, 1991, the parties submitted an executed Stipulation of Dismissal. According to the stipulation, the parties have agreed that certain administrative deficiencies in the Grantee's cash management practices have been corrected and that the dispute with respect to the \$2.2 million involved in this case has been resolved. Therefore, the parties jointly request dismissal of the Grantee's appeal as moot.
