

This matter arises under the Job Training and Partnership Act, 29 U.S.C. 5 1501 et seq., and the regulations issued thereunder at 20 C.F.R. Part 636.

On August 16, 1993, Counsel for Complainant informed this Office that his client and DOL have reached an agreement in this matter. In addition, Complainant has filed a Notice of Withdrawal of Appeal. In JTPA cases, the parties may choose to "[n]otify the administrative law judge that the parties have reached a full settlement and have agreed to dismissal [withdrawal] of the action." 29 C.F.R. S 18.9(c)(2). See also 20 C.F.R. S 636.10(c).

Accordingly, the Notice of Withdrawal of Appeal is GRANTED.


