## **Appendix E - “Other (Specify)” Coded responses by question number (variable name)**

Other-Specify responses are opportunities for the respondent to provide an explicit answer to selected survey questions other than the pre-coded options provided for coding by the interviewer. When this situation arises, the initial variable is coded as Other (Specify) and the specified response is coded in a new variable with the suffix Code. For example, SR1Code is the Other (Specify) response to SR1. SR1 is coded as 40:Other (Specify) and SR1Code is assigned a value from 42 – 93 (defined below), depending on the response given. Responses were collected over the course of the study, and assigned codes by the contractor after completion of the study.
