ORDER APPROVING SETTLEMENT AND DISMISSING CASE

This matter arises under the whistleblower protection provisions of the Sarbanes-Oxley Corporate and Criminal Accountability Act of 2002, 18 U.S.C. § 1514A.

On October 2, 2006, the parties filed a Confidential Settlement and Release Agreement. I find that the settlement agreement is fair, adequate, and voluntary, and it is hereby APPROVED. Pursuant to 29 CFR § 1980.111(e), the approved settlement agreement constitutes the final order of the Secretary and may be enforced pursuant to 29 CFR § 1980.113. The parties' stipulation that the claim shall be dismissed with prejudice and without costs, and with all parties waiving any and all rights of appeal is APPROVED, and this matter is DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE.
