- Administrative Guidance
 - Institutions not setting Target Percentages at 25% or based on actual FY 1997 expenditures need to reset Target Percentage on the lesser of:
 - 25% or
 - Two times the actual percentage of FY 1997 expenditures
 - Applies to FY 2009 and thereafter



- Administrative Guidance Time Line
 - Vet Proposed Revised Administrative Guidance
 - May 1, 2008 through June 30, 2008
 - Release Revised Administrative Guidance
 - July 15, 2008
 - Reconfirm/Reset Target Percentages
 - Due Date: August 15, 2008
 - Approval of Target Percentages
 - September 15, 2008



Administrative Guidance

- Legislation provides CSREES with waiver authority for these requirements
