Subj: PRECEPT CONVENING A SELECTION BOARD TO RECOMMEND OFFICERS OF  
THE COAST GUARD ON THE INACTIVE DUTY PROMOTION LIST FOR  
PROMOTION TO THE GRADE OF COMMANDER

1. Pursuant to the authority provided by references (a) and (b), a Selection Board is appointed consisting of yourself as President and the following members:

CDR Gregory S. Lingle, USCGR - Member  
CDR Kathleen A. Duignan, USCGR - Member  
CDR Sandra K. Selman, USCG - Member  
CDR James M. Kelly, USCGR - Member  
CDR Kevin H. Nishimura, USCGR - Member

LT Robert M. Cooper, USCGR - Non-voting Recorder

2. The Board shall convene at 0830, 30 July 2007, in suite 501, Coast Guard Personnel Command, or as soon thereafter as practicable, for the purpose of considering all officers in the grade of Lieutenant Commander who are eligible for consideration for promotion to the grade of Commander in the Coast Guard Reserve. Members of the Board shall swear or affirm that they will, without prejudice or partiality, and having in view both the special fitness of officers and the efficiency of the Coast Guard, perform the duties imposed upon them.

3. There is hereby established a promotion zone of 69 Lieutenant Commanders on the Inactive Duty Promotion List consisting of the most senior officer in the grade of Lieutenant Commander namely, Lieutenant Commander Kevin J. Collins, USCGR, and those 68 officers junior thereto who have not been previously included in a promotion zone, through and including Lieutenant Commander Ellen L. Hammer.

4. References (c), (d) and (e) authorize, when the needs of the service require, the consideration of officers for promotion from below the promotion zone. When selection from below the zone is authorized, the number selected may not exceed 10 percent of the maximum number of the best qualified officers that the board may select in zone. The maximum number of the best qualified officers that the board may select in zone is 54. Not more than 5 officers from below zone may be selected.

5. Prior to the date the Board submits its report, the Commander, Coast Guard Personnel Command is authorized to add or delete the name of any officer whose name is added to or removed from the Inactive Duty Promotion List for any reason. In the event any officer in the promotion zone established herein is added to or removed prior to the date the Board submits its report, the Commander, Coast Guard Personnel Command will provide additional instructions. Any communications to the Board by any officer under consideration will be transmitted under separate cover.

6. The Board shall refer to the provisions of Sections 5.A and 14.A of reference (f) and the enclosed Commandant's Guidance to PY08 Officer Selection Boards in your development of criteria for determining the officers recommended for selection. Section 14.A.3 of reference (f) provides four factors to consider in developing your criteria: performance, professionalism, leadership, and education.

7. You should emphasize to the members of the Board the importance of their obligation to confine themselves to facts of record and not predicate judgments on rumor or hearsay. At the end of your deliberations, all members must be able to say that the officers recommended for promotion are, in the opinion of at least two-thirds of the members of the Board (4 of 6 members), the best qualified to carry out the duties and responsibilities of the grade for which they are selected.

8. The Board shall submit a report in writing signed by all members of the Board. Except for the report of this Board, the proceedings of the Board shall not be disclosed to any person not a member of the Board. You will direct the members of the Board that their recommendations shall be kept confidential until the Secretary approves the report on behalf of the President, and the names of officers selected for promotion are released to the Service at large.

COMMANDER SELECTION BOARD ZONE

Ref: (a) My memo 1401 of 20 Jul 07

1. As stated in paragraph 4 of reference (a), prior to the date the Board submits its report, I am authorized to delete the name of any officer whose name is removed from the Inactive Duty Promotion List for any reason. One officer named below is on Extended Active Duty (EAD) and transferred from the IDPL to the ADPL, the other officer named below is a retired recall and ineligible for promotion on the IDPL. By law, these officers may not be considered for promotion on the IDPL. Therefore, I removed two names from the list of officers eligible for consideration by the PY08 IDPL Commander Selection Board. This is an administrative matter and does not constitute a selection for promotion or retention.
