The purpose of this memorandum is to request your assistance in providing data necessary for the annual progress reports for fiscal year (FY) 2005 on the Department of Energy's (DOE) implementation of Executive Orders 13101 and 13148. These reports are due to the Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ), the Office of Management and Budget, and the Environmental Protection Agency in March 2006. Pursuant to DOE Order 450.1, the Office of Environment, Safety and Health (EH) will prepare these annual corporate progress reports based on data provided by those sites under your purview.

The reports will reflect the Department's performance for FY 2005 on meeting Federal agency environmental management system (EMS), pollution prevention, and environmentally preferable purchasing goals and requirements. The DOE pollution prevention website is available for reporting FY 2005 data on reductions in the generation of waste and environmentally preferable purchasing of recycled-content and bio-based content products, and other pollution prevention accomplishments (www.eh.doe.gov/p2). Beginning October 1, 2005, the pollution prevention coordinators and green acquisition advocates at your sites will be provided with access to this website along with instructions on entering their FY 2005 performance data and site-specific accomplishments. A directory of pollution prevention coordinators and green acquisition advocates is provided for your information at attachment 1.

In addition to profiling the Department's pollution prevention performance, the reports will also present information on DOE's progress in implementing the EMS provisions of EO 13148 and DOE Order 450.1. These Orders require the implementation of an EMS at DOE sites by December 31, 2005. The Department's reported EMS progress will be based on data provided by your designated points of contact on the status of EMS implementation at each of your sites. DOE, along with other Federal agencies, will be scored by CEQ on its progress in meeting EO 13148 goals for EMS implementation.

A list of points of contact for EMS implementation is provided for your information at attachment 2.

I am requesting that the pollution prevention data needed for the Department's EO 13101 and EO 13148 progress reports from those sites under your purview be recorded electronically on the aforementioned pollution prevention website by the timelines shown in attachment 3.

Executive Summary

Executive Orders 13101, 13148, 13149, and Department of Energy (DOE) Order 450.1 require an annual report on each Federal agency's progress toward meeting the EO13148 goals in purchasing environmentally preferable products and services.

This report summarizes the Oak Ridge National Laboratory (ORNL) Fiscal Year (FY) 2005 purchases of the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA)-designated products that were obtained from non-Federal sources and includes ORNL's plans for improving performance. These results are entered in the DOE pollution prevention website (<http://www.eh.doe.gov/p2>). In FY 2005, ORNL purchased products in 34 of the 65 item categories on the EPA-designated products list.
