Plaintiff, the Federal Trade Commission ("FTC" or "Commission"), having filed a Complaint for Injunctive and Other Equitable Relief, including redress to consumers, pursuant to Section 13(b) of the Federal Trade Commission Act ("FTC Act"), 15 U.S.C. § 45(a), and having moved for an Order to show cause why a preliminary injunction pursuant to Rule 65 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and C.D. Ca. L.R. 65-1, and the Court having considered the Complaint, declarations, exhibits, memorandum of points and authorities, and other material filed by the parties, finds that:

- 1. This Court has jurisdiction of the subject matter of this case and there is good cause to believe it will have jurisdiction of all parties hereto;
- 2. There is good cause to believe that venue properly lies with this Court;
- 3. There is good cause to believe that the Defendant BurnLounge, Inc., engaged in acts and practices that violate Section 5(a) of the FTC Act, 15 U.S.C. § 45(a), and that the Commission is therefore likely to prevail on the merits of this action.

- 4. The evidence set forth in the "Plaintiff Federal Trade Commission's Memorandum of Points and Authorities Supporting the Application for a Noticed Ex Parte Temporary Restraining Order' and in the accompanying exhibits, and all other documents filed by the parties show that the Defendant engaged in a classic pyramid scheme in violation of Section 5 of the FTC Act, 15 U.S.C. § 45(a). In accordance with Fed. R. Civ. P. 65, good cause therefore exists for issuing this preliminary injunction. Furthermore, to preserve the Court's ability to grant effective relief, there is good cause for the Court to enter an order preserving certain assets and to require that Defendant provide an accounting of its assets and of the monies that it has received as a result of its activities challenged in the Complaint.
- 5. Weighing the equities and considering the Commission's likelihood of ultimate success, a preliminary injunction with asset preservation, requiring an accounting and other equitable relief is in the public interest.
- 6. As an agency of the United States, no security is required of the Commission for the issuance of a preliminary injunction. See Fed. R. Civ. P. 65(c).

#### **Definitions**

For the purpose of this preliminary injunction, the following definitions shall apply:

- 1. "Asset" or "Assets" means any legal or equitable interest in, right to, or claim to, any real and personal property, including, but not limited to chattel, goods, instruments, equipment, fixtures, general intangibles, licenses, inventory, checks, notes, leaseholds, effects, contracts, mail or other deliveries, shares of stock, lists of consumer names, accounts, credits, mortgages, premises, receivables, funds, and cash, wherever located, whether in the United States or abroad, and shall include both existing assets and assets acquired after the date of entry of this Order.
  - 2. "Defendant" means BurnLounge, Inc.

- 3. "Marketing Program" includes, but is not limited to, any multi-level marketing program, business investment opportunity, pyramid marketing scheme, Ponzi scheme, or chain marketing scheme that is marketed by any of the Defendants.
- 4. "Mogul Program" means the BurnLounge Mogul Program through which participants earn monetary rewards.
- 5. "Person" means a natural person, an organization or other legal entity, including a corporation, partnership, sole proprietorship, limited liability company, association, or cooperative, or any other group or combination acting as an entity.
- 6. "Plaintiff" means the Federal Trade Commission ("Commission" or "FTC").
- 7. The terms "and" and "or" in this Order shall be construed conjunctively or disjunctively as necessary, to make the applicable sentence or phrase inclusive rather than exclusive.

# <u>ORDER</u>

#### I. PYRAMID PROHIBITION

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Defendant is temporarily restrained and enjoined from engaging, participating or assisting in, any manner or capacity whatsoever, from operating the Mogul Program or any Marketing Program that:

- A. Pays any compensation related to recruitment;
- B. Pays any compensation related to the purchase or sale of goods or services unless the majority of such compensation is derived from sales to persons who are not members of the Mogul Program or the Marketing Program; or
- C. Otherwise constitutes a pyramid scheme.

#### II. INJUNCTION AGAINST MISREPRESENTATION

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, in connection with the advertising, promoting, marketing, offering or providing, or assisting others in the advertising, promoting, marketing, offering or providing the Mogul Program, or any other Marketing Program, the Defendant is hereby temporarily restrained and enjoined from making or assisting in the making of, expressly or by implication, orally or in writing, any false or misleading statement or representation of material fact, including, but not limit to: misrepresenting that consumers who participate in the Mogul Program, or any Marketing Program will or are likely to receive substantial income.

#### III. INJUNCTION AGAINST MATERIAL OMISSIONS

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, in connection with the advertising, promoting, marketing, offering or providing, or assisting others in the advertising, promoting, marketing, offering or providing the Mogul Program, or any Marketing Program, the Defendant is hereby temporarily restrained and enjoined from failing to disclose, clearly and conspicuously, orally or in writing, all information material to a consumer's decision to participate in the Mogul Program or any other Marketing Program, including, but not limited to, the fact that the structure of the Mogul Program or any other Marketing Program prevents the vast majority of participants from making substantial income.

#### IV. ASSET PRESERVATION

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant BurnLounge will place into escrow on a monthly basis twenty percent (20%) of its net profits earned from the date of this Order going forward. Net profits to be determined in accordance with commonly accepted accounting practices. Those funds shall remain preserved pending further order of the Court upon final resolution of this matter. The amount to be deposited in the escrow account shall be capped at an amount to be agreed upon by the parties or decided by further order of the Court. If the parties

are unable to agree on the amount of the cap and a Court hearing is necessary to determine the amount of the cap, the parties shall have the right to conduct expedited discovery and the right to file briefs. Any needed hearing shall be conducted within four months (4) and the decision of the Judge shall be final.

During the pendency of this proceeding, Defendant BurnLounge shall not dispose of any asset acquired prior to June 6, 2007, and shall provide by the 15th of each month from the date of this Order going forward, full and complete income statements of profit and loss prepared in accordance with commonly accepted accounting principles.

Provided further that Defendant BurnLounge may pay reasonable attorneys fees from available cash generated from future operations upon application to, and approval by the Court. The Commission shall have the right to oppose any fee application.

It is further provided that in the event Defendant BurnLounge ceases operation all assets, including but not limited to, proprietary software existing at the time of this order shall be turned over to the Commission.

#### V. FOREIGN ASSET REPATRIATION

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within five (5) business days following the service of this Order, Defendant shall:

- A. Provide the Commission with a full accounting of all funds, documents, and assets located outside of the United States which are (1) titled in the name, individually or jointly, of any Defendant; or (2) held by any person or entity for the benefit of any Defendant; or (3) under the direct or indirect control, whether jointly or singly, of any Defendant;
- B. Transfer to the territory of the United States all funds, documents, and assets located outside of the United States which are (1) titled in the name individually or jointly of any Defendant; or (2) held by any

person or entity for the benefit of any Defendant; or (3) under any Defendants' direct or indirect control, whether jointly or singly;

- C. Hold and retain all repatriated funds, documents, and assets, and prevent any transfer, disposition, or dissipation whatsoever of any funds or assets, except as required by this Order; or for any funds, documents, or assets held by or in the name of any Defendant; and
- D. Provide the Commission access to all records of funds, documents, or assets of any Defendant held by financial institutions or other entities or individuals located outside the United States by signing a Consent to Release of Financial Records, to be supplied by Plaintiff.

#### VI. INTERFERENCE WITH REPATRIATION

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Defendant is hereby temporarily restrained and enjoined from taking any action, directly or indirectly, which may result in the encumbrance or dissipation of funds, documents, or assets held outside of the United States, or in the hindrance of the repatriation required by the preceding Section of this Order, including but not limited to:

- A. Sending any statement, letter, fax, e-mail or wire transmission, telephoning or engaging in any other act, directly or indirectly, that results in a determination by a foreign trustee or other entity that a "duress" event has occurred under the terms of a foreign trust agreement until such time that all assets have been fully repatriated pursuant to the preceding Section of this Order; and
- B. Notifying any trustee, protector or other agent of any foreign trust or other related entities of either the existence of this Order, or of the fact that repatriation is required pursuant to a Court Order, until such time that all assets have been fully repatriated pursuant to the preceding Section of this Order.

#### VII. FINANCIAL STATEMENTS AND ACCOUNTING

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, within fifteen (15) business days after service of this Order, Defendant shall provide to counsel for Plaintiff:

- A. A completed financial statement signed under penalty of perjury and accurate as of the date of entry of this Order, in the form provided as Attachment B; and
- B. For product packages and digital music and other digital content sold by Defendants relating to BurnLounge, Inc., a detailed accounting verified under oath showing the following through the date of the issuance of this Order for the entire period of BurnLounge's operation and on a monthly basis:
  - gross revenue from the sale of each category of product
    package (i.e., Basic, Exclusive and VIP) and the number sold
    of each category of product package to each of the following:
    (a) Moguls and (b) non-Moguls;
  - gross revenue from aggregate sales of digital music and other digital content to each of the following: (a) Moguls and (b) non-Moguls;
  - 3. refunds and allowances on the sale of each category of product package (i.e., Basic, Exclusive and VIP) to each of the following: (a) Moguls and (b) non-Moguls;
  - 4. refunds and allowances on the aggregate sales of digital music and other digital content to each of the following: (a) Moguls and (b) non-Moguls;
  - net sales from the sale of each category of product package

     (i.e., Basic, Exclusive and VIP) and the number sold of each category of product package to each of the following:
     (a)
     Moguls and (b) non-Moguls;
  - 6. net sales from aggregate sales of digital music and other digital content to each of the following: (a) Moguls, (b) non-Moguls

Provided, as used in this paragraph, (a) "net sales" refers to gross revenue minus refunds and allowances; (b) "gross profit" refers to net sales minus cost of goods sold; © "Moguls" refers to all persons and entities that were Moguls at any time; and (d) "non-Moguls" refers to all person and entities that were never Moguls. Provided further that in providing information regarding Moguls for this paragraph, the information provided shall cover the entire period of that person or entity's association with BurnLounge as a retailer, customer, Mogul or under any other type of association.

#### VIII. MAINTENANCE OF RECORDS

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant, and their officers, agents, servants, employees, and attorneys, and those in active concert or participation with them who receive actual notice of this Order, are hereby temporarily restrained and enjoined from directly or indirectly destroying, mutilating, erasing, altering, concealing or disposing of, in any manner, directly or indirectly, any

- (3) "in any (... statement under penalty of perjury as permitted under section 1746 of title 28, United States Code) in any proceeding before or ancillary to any court or grand jury of the United States knowingly makes any false material declaration or makes or uses any other information . . . knowing the same to contain any false material declaration." (18 U.S.C. § 1623)

For a felony conviction under the provisions cited above, federal law provides that the fine may be not more than the greater of (i) \$250,000 for an individual or \$500,000 for a corporation, or (ii) if the felony results in pecuniary gain to any person or pecuniary loss to any person other than the defendant, the greater of twice the gross gain or twice the gross loss. 18 U.S.C. § 3571.
