Thank you for your comments on behalf of PeopleSystems regarding the proposed consent order in the above-captioned matter. Your letter requested that the Order be revised to add sales and marketing representatives to the categories of employees included in the Order as able to avoid their non-compete agreements when leaving TALX to work for another UCM provider.
