### Sea Service Requirements

**RECENCY** – (10.202(e)) – 90 days in the last 3 years on vessels of appropriate tonnage.

#### MATE 1600 GRT – (10.414)

- A. 1080 days of service on Ocean or N/C waters, **OF WHICH**
  - 1. 540 days of service must be in Ocean or N/C waters, **AND**
  - 2. 360 days of service on vessels over 100 GRT, **AND**
  - 3. 360 days of service as master, mate, or equivalent supervisory position while holding a license as master, mate, or master or mate of towing vessels, **AND**
  - 4. 180 days service as master, mate, or equivalent position on vessels over 100 GRT, **OR**
- B. 1080 days of service on Ocean or N/C vessels of over 200 GRT, **AND**
  - 1. 180 days of service as AB.
- C. Service gained in the engineroom **may be creditable** for up to 25% of the deck service requirements (10.410(b)).

#### MATE 500 GRT – (10.420)

- A. 720 days of service on Ocean or N/C waters, **OF WHICH**
  - 1. 360 days of service must be in Ocean or N/C waters, **AND**
  - 2. 360 days of service as master, mate, or equivalent supervisory position while holding a license as master, mate, or OUPV, **AND**
  - 3. 180 days as master, mate, or equivalent position on vessels over 50 GRT.
- B. Service gained in the engineroom may be creditable for up to 25% of the deck service requirements (10.410(b)).
