Sea Service Requirements

REGENCY (10.202(e)) 90 days in the last 3 years on vessels of appropriate tonnage.

MATE 200 – (10.454)

- A. **Great Lakes** – 180 days of service in the deck department, **OF WHICH**
 - 1. 90 days must have been in Great Lakes waters.
- B. **Inland** – 180 days of service in the deck department.
- C. Service gained in the engineeroom on vessels not more than 200 GRT **may be creditable** for up to 25% of the deck service requirements (10.450(b)).
- D. An OUPV INL may obtain this license by completing an examination, for GL waters, 90 days service must have been on the Great Lakes.

TONNAGE LIMITATION – (10.422)

- A. **200 Tons** – 45 days of service on vessels of 151 GRT or above, **OR**
 - 1. 90 days of service on vessels over 101 GRT.
- B. **150 Tons** – 45 days of service on vessels at 101 to 150 GRT, **OR**
 - 1. 90 days of service on vessels at 67 to 101 GRT.
- C. **100 Tons** – 45 days of service on vessels of 51 GRT or above, **OR**
 - 1. 90 days of service on vessels over 33.4 GRT.
- D. **50 Tons** – 1 day of service on vessels over 5.01 GRT.
- E. **25 Tons** – All service is on vessels of 5 GRT or less.

SAIL OR AUXILIARY SAIL – (10.454(b)) – 90 days of service on sail vessels.

ASSISTANCE TOWING – (10.482) – Must pass endorsement exam or approved course.
