You are on a multiple-product chemical tanker with orders to load diethylamine. What is NOT a requirement for transporting this cargo?

A. You must have two toxic vapor detectors or the pumproom must meet special requirements.

Incorrect: Two toxic vapors or the pumproom meeting special requirements are required for this product according to 46 CFR 153.526.

B. Each crew member must be provided with an emergency escape breathing apparatus.

Incorrect: An emergency escape breathing apparatus is required for each crewmember according to 46 CFR 153.527 when carrying this product.

C. You must have a containment system made out of stainless steel other than types 416 and 422.

Correct: Diethylamine does not refer to 46 CFR 153.530; therefore it does not need a containment system made out of stainless steel.

D. If you are also carrying allyl alcohol, the venting systems don't have to be segregated.

Incorrect: Since allyl alcohol refers to 46 CFR 153.1020, the same as diethylamine, then the piping and venting systems for both products do not have to be separated.
