Incorrect: Two toxic vapors or the pumproom meeting special requirements are required for this product according to 46 CFR 153.526.

- B. Each crew member must be provided with an emergency escape breathing apparatus. Incorrect: An emergency escape breathing apparatus is required for each crewmember according to 46 CFR 153.527 when carrying this product.
- C. You must have a containment system made out of stainless steel other than types 416 and 422.

Correct: Diethylamine does not refer to 46 CFR 153.530; therefore it does not need a containment system made out of stainless steel.

D. If you are also carrying allyl alcohol, the venting systems don't have to be segregated. Incorrect: Since allyl alcohol refers to 46 CFR 153.1020, the same as diethylamine, then the piping and venting systems for both products do not have to be separated.
