Which vessel is required to carry a Category 1, 406 MHz EPIRB installed to automatically float free? (small passenger vessel regulations)

Note: 46 CFR 180.64 states that each vessel that operates on the high seas or that operates beyond 3 miles from the coastline of the Great Lakes, must have on board a FCC Type Accepted Category 1, 406 MHz EPIRB, installed to automatically float free and activate. 46 CFR 25.26 states that high seas means the waters beyond a line three nautical miles seaward of the Territorial Sea Baseline as defined in 33 CFR 2.05-10.

A. A vessel operating within 3 miles from the coastline in the Gulf of Mexico. Incorrect. Not required by 46 CFR 180.64

B. A vessel operating on the ocean within 5 miles from the coastline. Incorrect, See. 46 CFR 25.26-10

C. A vessel operating beyond 3 miles from the coastline of the Great Lakes. Correct. See Note above.

D. A vessel operating exclusively on inland waters. Incorrect. Not required by 46 CFR 180.64
