Incorrect. This symbol represents thunderstorms, with or without precipitation.

B. H

Incorrect. This symbol represents slight shower(s) of soft or small hail with or without rain or rain and snow mixed.

C. G

Incorrect. This symbol represents a truncated example of a squall line.

D. F

Correct. This symbol represents a boundary of areas of significant weather.
