Thank you for your comments on behalf of the American Dental Hygienists' Association (ADHA) regarding the proposed consent order in the above-captioned matter. ADHA suggests the Commission insert some additional provisions in the order that ADHA believes would enhance dissemination of the terms of the order and also suggests that the order require the Board to publicize the Centers for Disease Control recommendations regarding school-based dental sealant programs. The Commission has reviewed ADHA's comment in connection with its decision whether to give final approval to the proposed consent order and has placed the comment on the public record.
