
Central New Mexico (Section 593)

(Construction General)

Central New Mexico was authorized in Section 593 of the Water Resources Development Act of 1999. The authority specifically applies to "Central New Mexico", defined as Bernalillo, Sandoval, and Valencia Counties. Section 593 authorizes the Corps of Engineers to provide assistance to non-Federal sponsors in the form of design and construction for water-related environmental infrastructure and resource protection and development of publicly owned projects, including projects for wastewater treatment and related facilities, water supply, conservation, and related facilities, storm water retention and remediation, environmental restoration, and surface water resource protection and development. Costs are shared on a 75% - 25% basis, with the Federal Government paying 75% and the non-Federal sponsor paying the remaining 25%.

FY 2007 work will include construction of Black Mesa Phase I, Rio Rancho Water Supply Upgrade (reimbursable Phase I), and financial closeout of Double Eagle II Airport.

The program is funded under the Construction General appropriation.
