Ecosystem Revitalization @ Route 66, New Mexico

(Construction General - Section 1135)

The project is located on the Rio Grande in Albuquerque, New Mexico between I-25 and Bridge Street. The project consists of the removal of unnecessary jetty jacks and non-native vegetation, the removal of dead trees to reduce fire hazard, the reintroduction of native vegetation, and the improvement of recreational opportunities that are compatible with eco-system recreation.

In FY 2007, the feasibility study will be completed and plans and specifications will be initiated.

The local sponsor for this project is the Middle Rio Grande Conservancy District.

This project is funded under the Construction General appropriation's Section 1135 Continuing Authority Program.
