

CANNON AIR FORCE BASE CLOVIS, NEW MEXICO

MISSION

Cannon Air Force Base, one of 20 major Air Combat Installations, lies in the high plains of eastern New Mexico near the Texas Panhandle. The base is six miles west of Clovis, New Mexico, and is 4,295 feet above sea level. Cannon is the home of the 27th Fighter Wing, which operates the F-16 tactical fighter. Cannon is one of the largest operational bases in the U.S. Air Force. In 2005, Cannon AFB was put on the Base Restoration and Closure (BRAC) list with the condition that a new mission be found for the base. In 2006, a potential new mission was found and Air Force Special Operations Command (AFSOC) will transition ownership of Cannon AFB from Air Combat Command (ACC).

PROGRAM SYNOPSIS

The District's mission at Cannon has one project currently under construction and two projects under re-design to support the 27^{th} Fighter Wing aircraft and associated personnel.
