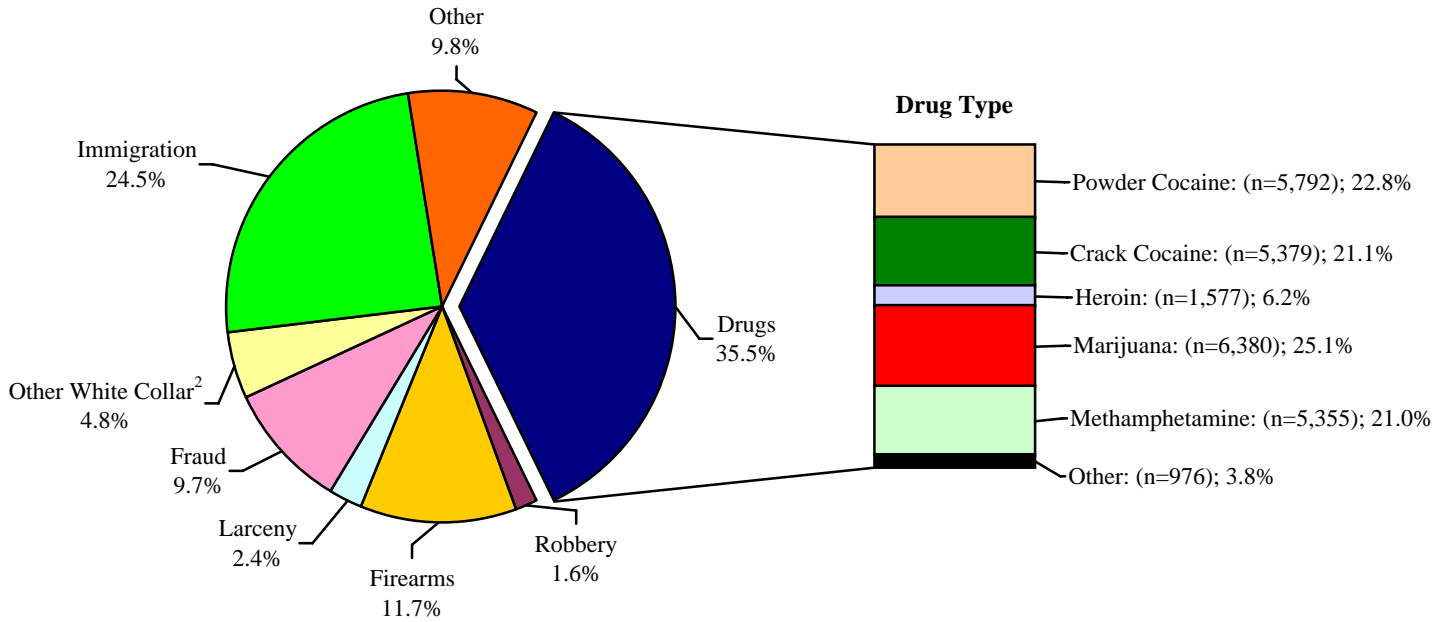
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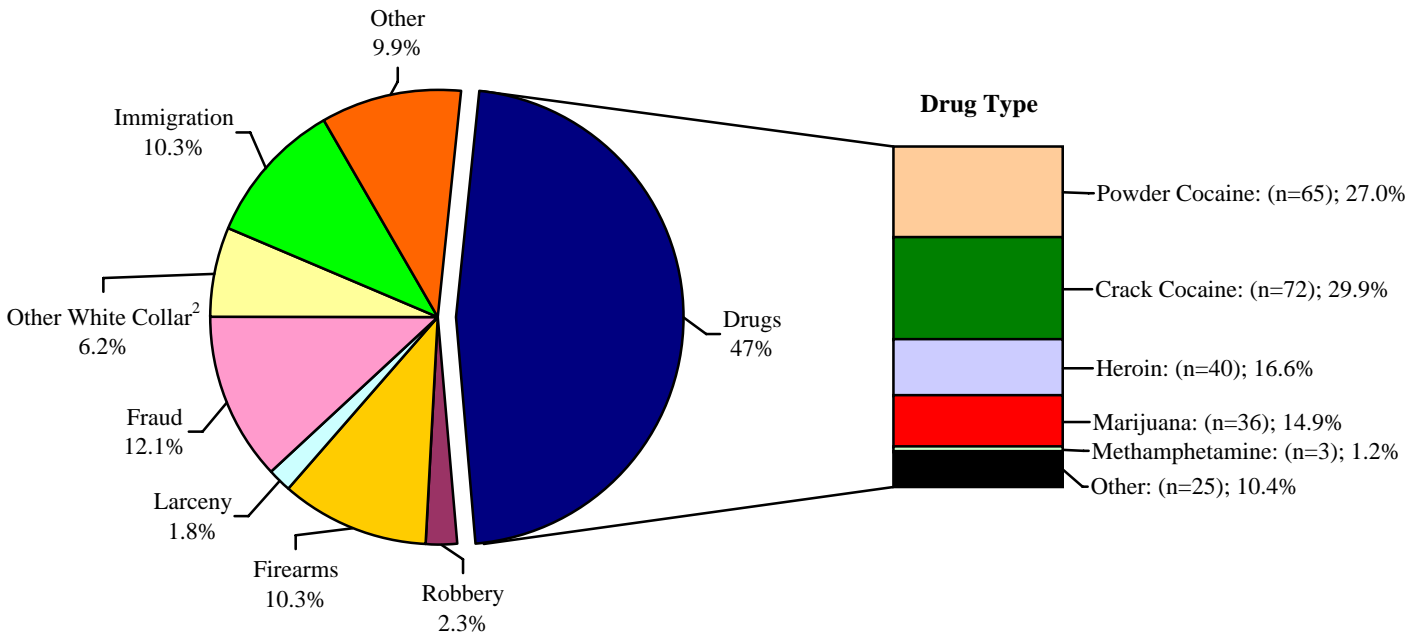

Of the 72,585 guideline cases, 2,398 were excluded due to missing information needed to determine the relationship between the sentence imposed and the guideline range. Districts for which information needed to determine the relationship between the sentence imposed and the guideline range is missing in five percent or more of the cases received included: Western Oklahoma (37.1%), Southern Georgia (37.1%), Central California (21.2%), Middle Georgia (19.6%), Eastern Virginia (18.4%), Western Washington (11.4%), Western Kentucky (10.8%), Alaska (7.5%), Northern Alabama (7.4%), Maryland (6.8%), Arizona (6.7%), Oregon (5.9%), Southern California (5.6%), and Northern New York (5.1%).
