Other important information

The License Reinstatement program is only valid with the circuit courts that participate.

Your license may be suspended with more than one circuit court. It is your responsibility to check the status of your driver's license with other circuit courts. Not all circuit courts participate in the License Reinstatement Program. If your license is suspended with a nonparticipating circuit court, as well as a participating one, enrolling in the License Reinstate Program will not reinstate your license with the non-participating circuit court.

The Driver and Motor Vehicle Services Division (DMV) requires a reinstatement fee. For more information on how you may reinstate your driver's license, contact the Oregon Department of Revenue and speak to an OAA agent today.
