Report Highlights:

The Spanish Ministry of Agriculture (MAPA) recently introduced a Web page displaying current and historical seafood prices. The weekly-updated prices may be of interest to U.S. exporters to the Spanish market.

Includes PSD Changes: No Includes Trade Matrix: No Unscheduled Report Madrid [SP1] [SP] MAPA recently debuted its new "Price Observatory" Web page, which, along with other agricultural product prices, tracks seafood prices at port of entry, at wholesale, and at the point of retail-sale. The Web page has current and historical prices, along with graphs showing the price evolution at the respective commercial levels.

MAPA's price-tracking Web page includes the species names in Spanish and the price information in Euros/Kilo on the following seafood species. Here below we provide the reader with the names in Spanish, the English translation, and the scientific name, respectively:

Merluza: Hake - Merlucius merlucius Pescadilla: Striped weakfish - Cynoscion striatus Sardinas: Sardines - Sardinops Anchoa o boqueron: Anchovy (salted or fresh) - Engraulis encrasicolus Gallos: Megrim - Lepidorhombus spp Jurel: Jurel - Horse Mackerel/ Scad - Trachurus trachurus Bacaladilla: Blue Whiting/ Poutassou - Micromesistius Poutassou Caballa: Mackerel - Scomber scombrus Trucha: Trout - Oncorhynchus Salmon: Salmon - Salmo salar(Atlantic) Chirla: Clam - Chamelea gallina Mejillon: Mussel - Mytilus galloprovincialis

The stated objective of the new MAPA price Web page is "to achieve market transparency within the food chain price establishing process using appropriate methodological and analytical tools."
