

Prioritization of PAP Funding Recommendations on Policy Merits

Priority 1: Increase RBRVS conversion factor

- a) increases all primary care service payments across the board
- b) direct, immediate impact on access

Priority 2: Admin build-up

- a) increases MCO flexibility in addressing primary care issues
- b) acknowledges MCO administrative burden involved in maximizing primary care effectiveness
- c) will not increase primary care payments across the board, or directly impact access

Priority 3: PCCM fee

- a) additional primary care services/capacity will need to be defined before fee is set
- b) as pass-through, PCCM fee will not increase MCO primary care management capacity but will require MCO administration

Priority 4: POP for Primary Care Innovations

- a) Not clear what this offers that isn't contained in above three options
