How To Mail Newborn Screening Specimens

Dried blood spots are not subject to 6.2 Infectious Material Department of Transportation requirements (49 CFR 173.134). Please follow these instructions carefully:

- 1. *Complete the entire Newborn Screening form*. Missing information has the potential to cause delayed or missed Newborn Screening disorders.
- 2. After collection of blood, allow specimen to dry at least three hours before processing for shipping.
- 3. Fold protective flap over dried blood.

- 4. Place specimen in self-addressed manila envelope that has been provided by the Newborn Screening Program. More than one specimen can be placed in this envelope.
- 5. Place the manila envelope in a Tyvek® envelope or cardboard envelope affixing mailing label to outside (see illustration). Please do NOT use boxes.
