

INHERITANCE AFFIDAVIT

INSTRUCTIONS

The State of Oregon Marine Board requires that if the estate of the owners is not being probated, the Certificate of Title for a Boat may be presented to the Board together with an affidavit signed by all heirs of the owners stating the name of the person to whom the ownership interest has passed.

- 1) The Marine Board must receive an affidavit completed and signed by all heirs. If there is more than one heir, the heirs may either complete and sign the same affidavit or complete and sign separate affidavits. The signatures must be signed before a Notary Public.
- 2) If the heir is a minor or incapacitated, the parent or guardian must sign for the heir. (Example: John Jones, 10, by Jim Jones, Parent)
- 3) If there are no other heirs who may have a claim to the vessel, state "none" in the space provided.
- 4) Submit the original Certificate of Title for a Boat with the section "Application by New Owner" filled out; the completed Inheritance Affidavit; a Proof of Death (copy of death certificate or obituary) and a \$30 title fee to the Oregon State Marine Board; PO Box 14145; Salem OR 97309-5065. If registration is due, the registration fees may be submitted at the same time. If the title is lost, a Lost Boat Title Application Form must be included.
