For Crop Week Ending Sunday, November 12, 2006

Released November 13, 2006

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CROP INFORMATION

Days suitable for fieldwork: 3.2

Soil moisture supplies: 0% very short, 8% short, 41% adequate and 51% surplus

Field Crops Report

Wet fields and occasional rain continued to limit field activities. Soybean harvest was completed. Cotton harvest edged closer to completion, but the recent rains have damaged the crop not yet harvested. Rice producers were water leveling fields for next year's rice crop. Sugarcane harvest continued with reports of good tonnage and sugar content. Wheat planting was moving along slowly due to the wet conditions.

Fruits, Vegetables and Specialty Crops

Producers were harvesting cabbage, eggplant, greenhouse and field tomatoes, satsumas, and strawberries. Wet fields were causing sweet potatoes to breakdown. Crawfish harvest had begun on a small scale.

Livestock, Pasture and Range Report

Cattle producers were beginning to feed cattle and marketing of spring calves was completed. Cattlemen were fertilizing winter pastures. Ryegrass planting continued, with reports of stands looking good.
