4 SEC. 3001. SHORT TITLE.

5 This title may be cited as the "Digital Transition and6 Public Safety Act of 2005.".

7 SEC. 3002. ANALOG SPECTRUM RECOVERY; HARD DEAD8 LINE.

9 Section 309(j)(14) of the Communications Act of
10 1934 (47 U.S.C. 309(j)(14)) is amended—

(1) by striking "December 31, 2006." in subparagraph (A) and inserting "April 7, 2009.";

13 (2) by striking subparagraph (B);

of 1934 (47 U.S.C. 309(j)(11)) is amended by striking
"September 30, 2007." and inserting "September 30,
2009.".

21 SEC. 3004. SUPPLEMENTAL LICENSE FEES.

In addition to any fees assessed under the Communications Act of 1934 (47 U.S.C. 151 et seq.), the Commission shall assess extraordinary fees for licenses in the aggregate amount of \$10,000,000, which shall be depos4

ited in the Treasury during fiscal year 2006 as offsetting
 receipts.

3 SEC. 3005. DIGITAL TRANSITION AND PUBLIC SAFETY 4 FUND.

5 (a) ESTABLISHMENT.—There is established in the
6 Treasury of the United States a fund called the Digital
7 Transition and Public Safety Fund.

8 (b) DEPOSIT OF AUCTION PROCEEDS.—The Com-9 mission shall deposit the proceeds of the auction author-10 ized by section 309(j)(15)(C)(v) of the Communications 11 Act of 1934 (47 U.S.C. 309(j)(15)(C)(v)) in the Fund as 12 required by item (III) of that section.

(c) PAYMENTS AUTHORIZED.—The Secretary of
Commerce or the Secretary's designee shall make payments from the Fund in the following amounts, for the
following programs, and in the following order:

(1) \$3,000,000,000 for a program to assist consumers in the purchase of converter boxes that convert a digital television signal to an analog television
signal, and any amounts unexpended or unobligated
at the conclusion of the program shall be used for
the program described in paragraph (3).

(2) \$200,000,000 for a program to convert lowpower television stations and television translator
stations from analog to digital, and any amounts un-

expended or unobligated at the conclusion of the
 program shall be used for the program described in
 paragraph (3).

4 (3) \$1,250,000,000 for a program to facilitate 5 communications, of which emergency 6 \$1,000,000,000 shall be used for an interoperability 7 fund and \$250,000,000 shall be used to implement 8 a national alert system, of which \$50,000,000 shall 9 be used for tsunami warning and coastal vulner-10 ability programs.

(4) \$250,000,000 for a program to implement
the ENHANCE 911 Act of 2004 (47 U.S.C. 942
note).

14 (5) \$200,000,000 for a program to provide as15 sistance to coastal States and Indian tribes affected
16 by hurricanes and other coastal disasters.

17 (d) TRANSFER OF AMOUNT TO TREASURY.—On Oc18 tober 2, 2009, Secretary shall transfer \$5,000,000,000
19 from the Fund to the general fund of the Treasury.

20 (e) OBLIGATION TIME PERIOD.—The amounts pay21 able from the Fund under subsection (c) shall be obligated
22 no later than September 14, 2010.

(f) EXCESS PROCEEDS USED FOR DEFICIT REDUCTION.—If the proceeds of the auction authorized by section 309(j)(15)(C)(v) of the Communications Act of 1934

1 (47 U.S.C. 309(j)(15)(C)(v)) exceed the sum of the pay2 ments under subsection (c), the transfer under subsection
3 (d), and any amount made available under section 3006,
4 the excess in the Fund shall be transferred to and depos5 ited in the general fund of the Treasury as miscellaneous
6 receipts.

7 SEC. 3006. ESSENTIAL AIR SERVICE PROGRAM.

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—If the amount appropriated to 9 carry out the essential air service program under sub-10 chapter II of chapter 417 of title 49, United States Code, equals or exceeds \$110,000,000 for fiscal year 2006, 11 2007, 2008, 2009, or 2010, then the Secretary of Com-12 13 merce shall make \$15,000,000 available from the Digital Transition and Public Safety Fund available to the Sec-14 15 retary of Transportation for use in carrying out the essential air service program for that fiscal year. 16

17 (b) APPLICATION WITH OTHER FUNDS.—Amounts
18 made available under subsection (a) for any fiscal year
19 shall be in addition to any amounts—

20 (1) appropriated for that fiscal year; or

(2) derived from fees collected pursuant to section 45301(a)(1) of title 49, United States Code,
that are made available for obligation and expenditure to carry out the essential air service program
for that fiscal year.
