NEW CHEQUAMEGON-NICOLET NATIONAL FOREST DEPUTY SUPERVISOR SELECTED

Rhinelander and Park Falls, Wis. –July 12, 2007 –Forest Supervisor, Jeanne Higgins, has announced the selection of Tony Erba as the new Deputy Forest Supervisor for the Chequamegon-Nicolet National Forest (CNNF). Tony is currently filling the role as the Acting Deputy Forest Supervisor and will transition into the job permanently in early September. Tony has been with the Forest Service for twenty-one years.
